PRAYER HELP

Here is one tool to help you seek the Lord in prayer.
(adapted from Focus On The Family)

P^{raise}
R^{epent}
A^{sk}
Y^{ield (Listen)}

Praise: We are to “enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise” Psalm 100:4. Sit quietly and praise God for who He is and thank God for what He has done.

Repent: “If we confess our sins, God is faithful and just to forgive us of our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness,” 1 John 1:9. Confession begins with admitting we are sinners and trusting God to be faithful to cleanse us. Repentance means turning away from sin and turning toward God. Psalm 66:18: “If I had cherished sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened.”

Ask: God knows what we are going to ask before we even ask it — “All my longings lie open before you, O Lord: my sighing is not hidden from you” Psalm 38:9. Even so, we are to talk to Him about our needs, our joy, our frustration, and ask for what we need.

Yield: The fact that we have brought our prayer list before God indicates our trust that He will, in His time and in His way, show us the way we should go (see Psalm 143:8). Look and listen for God’s answer to our prayer requests.

Praise: We are to “enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise” Psalm 100:4. Sit quietly and praise God for who He is and thank God for what He has done.

Repent: “If we confess our sins, God is faithful and just to forgive us of our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness,” 1 John 1:9. Confession begins with admitting we are sinners and trusting God to be faithful to cleanse us. Repentance means turning away from sin and turning toward God. Psalm 66:18: “If I had cherished sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened.”

Ask: God knows what we are going to ask before we even ask it — “All my longings lie open before you, O Lord: my sighing is not hidden from you” Psalm 38:9. Even so, we are to talk to Him about our needs, our joy, our frustration, and ask for what we need.

Yield: The fact that we have brought our prayer list before God indicates our trust that He will, in His time and in His way, show us the way we should go (see Psalm 143:8). Look and listen for God’s answer to our prayer requests.
